



**INSTRUCTIONS  
3D BUTTERFLY and TAG**

Trace the butterfly also the extra wings in white pencil.  
 Remove from pattern working on the back dorso the wings in a colour or colours of your choice.  
 (I used old gold and purple blending the two together )  
 Still working on the back emboss the traced pencil lines with your stylus .  
 Emboss each wing working from the body of the butterfly to the outer edge.  
 Emboss the butterfly body. (See finished picture) Using the sun tool emboss between the two outer lines on the wings.  
 Turn over and from the front using either a two needle tool or scissors go around the outer edge of the butterfly and extra wings. Glue wings in place and allow to dry also glue stamens in place to look like antennae.  
 For the greeting label, simply trace in special gold ink and emboss around the edges.  
 Cut out with scissors and fasten with a short gold thread. attach this under the butterfly to give the impression that the butterfly is bringing the message.  
 I have allowed the tag to swing freely so it moves but you can glue it down if you prefer.

Make 4 of these 3D flowers.  
 Trace in white tinta ink, emboss and colour as main pattern flowers.  
 Pierce around the outer edges with a 2-needle tool  
 Cut with scissors down the side of each petal from the perforations towards the centre remembering to leave a small piece in the centre of the flower in tact.  
 Glue to the X marks in each corner of the pattern.
